# Reading

- ▶ According to statistics a child who reads more than others is more likely to be successful in their career.
- ▶ Please ensure your child is reading at home for at least 20 minutes ideally daily, realistically as much as you can. The more the better! 😊
- ▶ Your child can write in their reading record when they have read at home individually as well as an adult writing in it when they have read to someone.
- ▶ Your child will have their banded books and a reading for pleasure book in their bag. The band books are relative to their reading ability. The pleasure book is a free choice of a book that interests the child to encourage reading. Even if the book is challenging, reading this will be more beneficial than not reading!
- ▶ Reading bands will be assessed every half term.
