Dear Parents and Carers,

Learning:

Our learning walk this week has been centred around safeguarding and behaviours for learning. The children were all settled, focussed and enjoying the learning in class. The classrooms all look wonderful. The teaching environments are exciting and engaging and the learning walls are being used and added to by the children. Pupil voice tells us that children feel happy, safe and settled in their new classes. **Communication:**

This is so class teachers can safely see the children to their classroom. We appreciate your understanding. **Parking:**

Please can we ask that our families park considerately and safely on the roads around the school at drop off and pick up times. We understand there is very little space to park and it is very busy but we would ask that you park further away and walk the last part of the journey, if you have to drive. We are mindful of road safety and how easy it is for a young child to slip their parent's hand and run into the road. We also need to maintain access for emergency vehicles. Where possible please walk to school which is in line with our healthy school ethos.

We would also remind parents to turn off the engines whilst waiting to reduce emissions and the impact on the environment.

Drop off and pick up arrangements:

Thank you for your patience during drop off and pick up. We appreciate that it has been busy. We would ask that the parents of older children stand back from the gates by preschool to allow the little ones to be collected by their teacher. Families with buggies please can you be mindful of not blocking passage to the walk way for the other children and to wait by the hedge.


