Dear Parents/Carers,

We loved welcoming all Layston children to school this morning and were especially proud of our new reception class. Arrival and collection information:

Arrival	Gates will open at 8:40am. Please arrive in school on time so children can enter their classrooms at 8:45am. The entry gates will close at 8:55am. The registration period ends at 9:00am.
Collection	Gates will open just before 3:15pm. Please arrive to collect your child at 3:15pm when school finishes. Gates will close by 3:25pm. At pick up, please wait patiently on the bottom playground, in your allocated class zone, for your child's class teacher to dismiss your child to you. This is to ensure that handovers at the end of the day are smooth and children are safe. Thank you for your patience and support with this. Any child arriving after 9:00am but before 9:30am will be marked as late. Any child arriving after 9:30am will be marked as absent for the whole morning session. Uniform:

All long hair should be tied back and please keep hair accessories simple, small and in line with our uniform policy.

What will my child need in school?

Your child will need:

- Water bottle
- A healthy snack, remember we are a nut free school
- Coat
- Sun hat, weather dependent
- Forest School and PE kit, this can be worn into school instead of uniform on relevant days. Please include joggers in cooler weather because most PE sessions will be outdoors.
- A small school bag, including a change of clothing for younger children

Children can also bring in their own healthy packed lunch. At Layston, we promote healthy lifestyles.
