What should you do if someone is unkind?	e.g. Tell an adult	Tell the teacher, if people are unkind, tell the teacher or a grown up Go and tell a teacher Tell an adult. Give them space. Tell an adult. Stay away from them and play with someone else. Tell your parents when you get home. If you are upset, your parents can check if you are okay and help deal with it. Tell a teacher
What can you do if you see someone being unkind to someone else?	Tell an adult Go and play with them	Play with them.  Don't shout or communicate with them, get an adult. Tell them to stop being unkind.  Go and tell and adult, tell them to stop, help them deal with it, go close and shout STOP  Tell an adult
What is bullying?- read explanation and make sure everyone is clear it is not a one off incident	e.g. "behaviour by an individual or a group, repeated over time that intentionally hurts another individual either physically or emotionally". (DfE)	Being unkind, we spoke about what this means This needs revisiting as they were confused and thought any unkindness was bullying. SB to action. It means it keeps happening. Physical hurting and kicking over and over. They keep taking things from you. Bullying is when you are mean to someone, physically or using unkind words, over a long period of time or every day. When someone picks on you over and over, it can include saying unkind things.
What is it, if it is not bullying?	Unkind, teasing, threatening, mean, disrespectful, annoying	If they just do it once, it might be just being mean. They're just being unkind. Being unkind or someone has made a bad decision.

What should you do if you hear fire/lock down alarm?	e.g. Stay quiet Follow teacher instruction Keep calm	Fire drill - Go quietly and line up and follow the teacher Go outside with an adult, line up, stay calm.
